

CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Paul Helenberg called the June 26, 2014 special meeting of the Castle Rock City Council to order at 6:05 p.m., followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Meeting was held in the Building/Planning room at City Hall. The following councilmembers were present: Lee Kessler, Earl Queen, Mike Davis and Ellen Rose. Councilmember Teter was absent. Also present: Chief of Police Bob Heuer, Sergeant Scott Neves, City Attorney Frank Randolph and Clerk-Treasurer Ryana Covington

Purpose of the meeting: to consider hiring interim part-time personnel for the police department due to recent vacancy of a full-time position.

Councilmember Queen made a motion, seconded by Kessler to approve hiring of reserve police officers for a maximum of four positions until the vacant full time position is permanently filled.

Discussion: Councilmember Kessler stated the part-time positions must be under 79 hours and will not include any benefits. Pay rate will be \$22.71/hour.

Vote on the motion: Unanimous 'Aye'. Motion carried.
