## **Dear Business Owners and Residents,**

Our goal is to keep you informed of progress and modifications to the Front Avenue NW Improvement Project. We hope to send out a notice every Thursday, if time allows.

It is our common goal to maintain safe pedestrian and vehicle passage to businesses and residences throughout the duration of this project, although there may be short periods when this is not feasible.

During the week of June 20<sup>th</sup> to 26<sup>th</sup>, 2013 the following work is expected on Front Avenue NW from Huntington Avenue N to Jackson Street NW:

- 1. Weather permitting; the first layer of asphalt pavement will be applied on Monday the 24th. Access for this day will be very limited due to the nature of this work. The contractor will provide a notice on instructions regarding timing and access for this day.
- 2. Continue construction of driveway approaches and sidewalks.
- 3. Continue the installation of electrical conduit for street lighting.

During this work, we anticipate that Front Avenue NW will be closed to vehicular traffic from Huntington Avenue N to Shintaffer Street NW. However, access will be maintained to Cowlitz River Dental and the Red Canoe Credit Union. Residential access on Barr Street and Cherry Street NW will also be provided.

As with any construction project, there may be times when the situation changes rapidly. Circumstances beyond our control may result in an unexpected alteration to vehicle and/or pedestrian access or utility services. Please be aware that the contractor, Tapani Underground, Inc. and the City of Castle Rock will do everything within our power to resolve issues as soon as possible. Let us know if you have any special needs and we will do our best to minimize the impact from this project.
