This is a semi-technical, very physically demanding position involving daily maintenance and operations of the public works facilities, including, but not limited to streets, water, wastewater, storm systems and treatment facilities. Responsibilities include maintenance and operation of equipment, system tanks, pumps, monitoring gauges and vehicles used by the Public Works Department. Position is full-time, requiring additional on-call response. Some examples of the physical demands are climbing, heavy lifting, digging and sweeping. Strong mechanical skills are preferred.

Applicant must have a high school diploma or equivalency and a good driving record. The successful applicant will be required to pass a respiratory physical, a pre-employment Drug/Alcohol screening and a complete background investigation. Applicant must possess, or be able to obtain within nine months of employment, a Class 'B' with air brakes Washington State Commercial Drivers License.

The successful applicant will be required to obtain within 24 months of employment the following Washington State Certifications:
