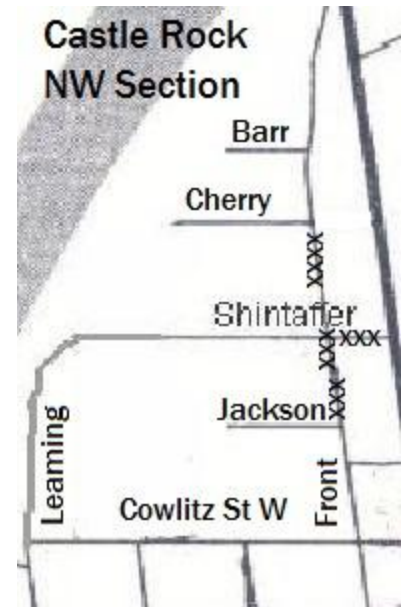


Front Avenue NW Improvement Project Week of July 4th to July 10th, 2013

Dear Business Owners and Residents,

Our goal is to keep you informed of progress and modifications to the Front Avenue NW Improvement Project. We hope to send out a notice every Thursday, if time allows.

It is our common goal to maintain safe pedestrian and vehicle passage to businesses and residences throughout the duration of this project, although there may be short periods when this is not feasible.

During the week of July 4th to July 10th, 2013 the following work is expected on Front Avenue NW from Cherry Street to Jackson Street NW:

1. Removal of street surface and sidewalk material from Shintaffer Street to Jackson Street NW and
2. Continue water and sewer main replacement.

During this work, we anticipate that **Front Avenue NW will be closed to vehicular traffic from Cherry Street NW to Jackson Street NW**. Access to Cowlitz River Dental and the Red Canoe Credit Union will now be from the north via Huntington Ave N. Residential access on Barr Street and Cherry Street NW will also be provided. During this work, Shintaffer Street NW will be accessed via Learning Avenue NW. The anticipated street closures are illustrated above.

As with any construction project, there may be times when the situation changes rapidly. Circumstances beyond our control may result in an unexpected alteration to vehicle and/or pedestrian access or utility services. Please be aware that the contractor, Tapani Underground, Inc. and the City of Castle Rock will do everything within our power to resolve issues as soon as possible. Let us know if you have any special needs and we will do our best to minimize the impact from this project.
